Our Marching Tigers have been performing in the same uniforms since 1983 (the year Armada's band program was reinstated). Our uniforms are so old we can no longer purchase additional ones to address our growing numbers. They have become threadbare, are fraying, and are almost impossible to repair. This year the Marching Tigers did not have enough uniforms to outfit every band member. Twenty-five incoming freshmen will be entering our program in September with no uniforms available. To properly outfit our Marching Tigers, we must purchase 100 uniforms at approximately \$300 each.

Our growing middle school bands and orchestras are also in need of uniforms. Presently students wear parent-provided clothing. \$75 will purchase a uniform blazer for our students as they positively represent Armada Schools at concerts and competitions.
