On behalf of the Port Huron Area School District, we are pleased to welcome you to District XVI High School Marching Band Festival to be held on October 11, 2011. Attached you will find maps of Port Huron including bus entrance and parking, warm-up area, performance area, equipment drop area, and concession area. Our goal is to help make this festival an educational experience for your band.

Headquarters for this festival will be located inside of Port Huron High School. In case of an emergency my cell phone will be on (810) 841-4534. Please **do not** arrive at PHHS before 5:00 p.m. There will be an adult guide to assist you from the time you arrive until the award ceremony has been completed.

After the director has checked in at headquarters your band will be taken to their assigned coat room(s). Directors, if you **do not** intend to use the room please contact me as soon as possible.

All equipment vehicles and trailers will use the parking lot located at the back of PHHS between the school and the stadium. This area is reserved for equipment vehicles, workers and directors.

If your band uses pit percussion trailers, please contact me as soon as possible. I have a setup crew that will assist your pit percussion for the performance. Please notice that pit equipment will enter from the Southwest gate and exit the stadium from the Northeast gate.

**Please note that Memorial Stadium does not have a track.** Pass and Reviews are possible **BUT** must be done about 5 yards on the field. Please reserve the sideline area for pit equipment and crews during the transition times. The stadium is a great place to perform and I trust you and your students will enjoy performing here. The crowd is considerably closer than stadiums with tracks. Please don't hesitate to call me if you have questions about the set-up of the stadium.

Please encourage your students to support the Port Huron High School Band Boosters by visiting the concession stand. There will be pizza, hot dogs, candy and beverages available. These concessions help defray the cost of hosting the festival. Also, please inform your Band Boosters that outside food **will not** be allowed in the building. Under no circumstances should any food be taken into the classrooms.

The PH Band Boosters will provide dinner for workers, directors, and adjudicators from 5:00 p.m. – 6:15 p.m. in our Media Center.

Finally, please remind your students that all classrooms should be left exactly as they find them upon entering the school. Please refrain from using the teacher's desk area. Also, instruments should only be played in the designated warm-up area during your scheduled warm-up time.
