Maintain guest cost at \$20.00 per person and raise performer cost to \$15.00 to cover cost of meal. Stop selling tickets on 4/09/12. At door \$25.00 and \$20.00 for student. Having flyers available at Pre-festival concerts. Chorale will perform along with Jazz and Orchestra. Steve will invite a few MS students to perform to increase awareness at that level.

MS – Music Composition Project: 01/08/13 No new update. As part of Keenan's final project towards completing his master's degree he will work with the students on the benefits of music composition. As part of the research process Keenan has enlisted the help of a friend (Dan Walshaw) who will make frequent trips to Armada from his home in Washington D.C. to help with the composition process. He will also compose an original piece of music for one of the ensembles for the spring concert. This is a great opportunity for our district. The average cost for an original composition is between \$3,000 to \$5,000. Dan has agreed to waive the costs to compose the piece of music. In appreciation for his generosity the boosters will cover the cost of airfare if applicable, along with funding an appreciation gift which will be presented to him at the spring concert.
